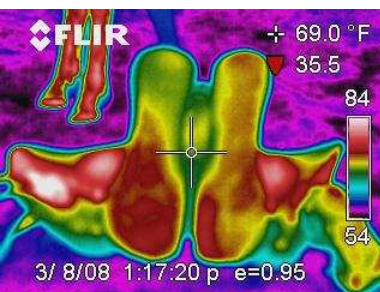

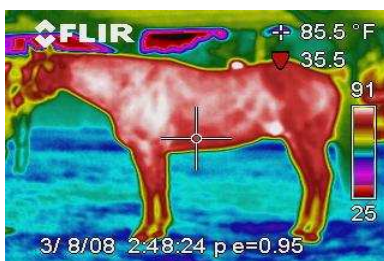
Abscesses at poll

Inflammation: neck & shoulder !!

Thermal imaging is a useful, non-invasive diagnostic tool for:
